ARBenefits Bariatric Program Re-Opens February 1, 2021

The 2021 ARBenefits Bariatric Program will be accepting applications beginning February 1, 2021. Act quickly as our program is only available to 300 applicants, and eligible candidates will be selected on a first come, first served basis.

Who Can Apply?

Only ARBenefits members who meet the following requirements can apply. Dependents or spouses are not eligible for this benefit.

Bariatric Program Eligibility Requirements

- Remained an ARBenefits policy holder for at least 1 year as of February 1, 2021
- Obtained a BMI between 36-59 with a weight related comorbidity, or BMI between 40-59 without a comorbidity
- Have no previous bariatric surgery
- Prepared to cover all member cost-share at or before the scheduled surgery date
- Participate in monthly Case Management phone calls Monday- Friday between 8:00 am to 4:00 pm
- Undergo the surgery on or before December 31, 2021
- Continue to be an active employee at time of surgery

How Do I Apply?

Eligible employees may enroll by completing the 2021 Bariatric Enrollment Form in their <u>member portal</u> and selecting the "Forms" tab located on the right hand side of the page.

How Will I Know If I Have Been Accepted into the Program?

You will be contacted by a member of the Health Advantage Case Management team no later than March 31, 2021 if you have been selected as a potential candidate. Make sure you provide a phone number and email that you check regularly. Add this number to your contacts as the Advantage Case Management team so that you know when they call: 1-800-378-2000. If you are not selected, you will receive an email via your member portal.

What Else Should I Know?

Before applying, please make sure you aware of all the program requirements. If any or all of these requirements are not fulfilled, your surgery will not be covered by ARBenefits. You may review them <u>here.</u>
