8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS GEOGRAPHIC  
10 INFORMATION SYSTEMS OFFICE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING  
11 JUNE 30, 2020; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS GEOGRAPHIC  
15 INFORMATION SYSTEMS OFFICE APPROPRIATION  
16 FOR THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
23 Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
24 the following maximum number of regular employees.

4 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas  
 5 Geographic Information Systems Office for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the  
 6 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as  
 7 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one  
 8 (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to  
 9 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or  
 10 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.  
 11

12 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 13 to the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be payable from the  
 14 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating  
 15 expenses of the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the fiscal  
 16 year ending June 30, 2020, the following:

 31 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - GEOSTOR AND FRAMEWORK. There is hereby  
 32 appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be  
 33 payable from the Geographic Information Systems Fund, to carry out the  
 34 duties, responsibilities, and authority of the Arkansas State Land  
 35 Information Board as described by Arkansas Code 15-21-504; to create,  
 36 operate, and maintain Geostor, the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure; and

1 to create, update, maintain, and disseminate framework spatial data as  
2 defined by Arkansas Code 15-21-502 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020,  
3 the following:

9 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
11 OF CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of funds remaining on June 30 of  
12 each fiscal year in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for the Arkansas  
13 Geographic Information Office, shall be transferred to the Geographic  
14 Information Systems Fund to be used for operating and maintaining the  
15 Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure, creating, updating, maintaining and  
16 disseminating framework spatial data as defined by Arkansas Code §15-21-502.

17 (1) Prior to June 30, 2020 the Agency shall by written statement set forth  
18 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of  
19 Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

20 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall  
21 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the  
22 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting  
23 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or  
24 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name  
25 or line item, the funding source of the appropriation and a copy of the  
26 written request set forth in (1) above;

27 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written  
28 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee  
29 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written  
30 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose, etc.

31 for which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty  
32 (30) days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution  
33 presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget  
34 Committee; and

35 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include  
36 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals

1 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board Commission or  
2 Institution.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
4 2019 through June 30, 2020.

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6 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
7 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
8 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
9 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
12 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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16 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
18 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
19 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
27 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of  
29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
30 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
31 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm  
32 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
33 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
34 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
35 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
