- Dial-in: Users can dial into meetings from their phones, which is very useful for those who are on the road and can't attend a session using the Microsoft Teams app on their laptops or mobile devices
- Large Capacity: Allows up to 1,000 phone attendees
- Better Call Quality: The call quality is often better when dialing in
- Dial-out: After attendees have joined the meeting, they can also dial out and invite other callers into a Teams meeting
- Global Accessibility: Users can use toll and toll-free phone numbers to dial into meetings
